# *INTRODUCTION*

Radrick Farms Golf Course was the gift of Frederick C. Matthaei, Sr., loyal alumnus and Regent of the University. It is named in honor of his sons, Konrad and Frederick. In 1965, Mr. Matthaei donated the property and funds for the construction of the course at the suggestion of President Harlan Hatcher.

Owned and operated by the University of Michigan, Radrick Farms Golf Course is a championship eighteen-hole course designed by world-renowned golf course architects Pete & Alice Dye. The 275-acre rolling layout is located just east of U of M campus.

As a self-sustaining unit within the University, Radrick relies solely on its operational income and the generosity of donors. For 60 seasons, our team has taken great pride in being stewards of this historic property, always striving to deliver an exceptional experience grounded in service, innovation, and integrity. We will continue to deliver a great value to our golfers while ensuring a sustainable operation for the next sixty seasons, furthering the University of Michigan's mission while offering the benefits of the game of golf and sharing this amazing property with the U of M community.

Radrick Farms Golf Course is operated for the benefit of the University of Michigan community. Faculty, staff, and select donors may play the course on a daily green fee basis. Eligible golfers can join our Season Pass Holder waitlist.

## **MATTHAEI CLUB AFFILIATES DAILY FEE**

- Become a member of this eligible group with a seasonal donation to the University of \$700.
- Contributions are accepted in the golf shop by cash or check - payable to the **University of Michigan**.
- Tee times can be made 10 days in advance.
- May bring up to three guests per round.
- Subject to availability. Visit [our website](#) to join the waitlist.

## DAILY-FEE GOLFERS

- Includes faculty/staff, Presidential Society, and Matthaiei Club members.
- Can make tee times 7 (Faculty/Staff, Presidential Society) or 10 (Matthaiei Club) days in advance.
- May bring up to 3 guests per group.
- Eligible to book mini-outings (see pg. 7).

**ALL GOLFERS: Please make sure all player information is as accurate as possible when reserving a tee time. Please update all player names, once known, prior to round.**

## WEEKEND TEE TIME LOTTERY

- All weekend and holiday tee times are allocated through a lottery process.
- Entries are submitted via Google form by Monday(s) at 8AM to be included in the drawing for following weekend (12-13 days in advance).
- **NEW for 2026:** Only one non-Season Pass Holder is permitted per foursome before 10AM to protect access for our Season Pass Holders.

**NEW: Weekend Lottery process and tee times prior to 10AM are exclusive for Season Pass Holders.**

# *RESERVATIONS CONTINUED*

---

## **YOUTH** (Up to 15 years old) & **YOUNG ADULT** (16-21 years old)

- Golfers under 18 years old must be accompanied by an eligible adult golfer that takes responsibility for the safety and actions of the youth while on the golf course, OR have a liability form signed by an adult.
- Cart use restrictions (see p.8).
- Youth restrictions do not apply to Fred Jr. Season Pass Holders.
- No access to online booking portal.
- Children of Season Pass Holders (under age 22) are eligible to purchase a Youth Season Pass (includes Range Pass).

## **CLUB TEAM SEASON PASS**

- Unlimited greens fees
- 7-day advance booking for tee times after 12PM.
- Complimentary use of driving range and practice facilities.
- Guests not permitted.
- Includes Golf Association of Michigan (GAM) membership and United States Golf Association (USGA) Handicapping service.
- Pass valid through September 1st, 2026.
- You must check-in with the Golf Shop and present a valid photo ID each time you play.

## **WALK-ONS**

- Eligible golfers without reservations may play on a first-come, first-served basis in any open tee times; we recommend calling the Golf Shop before arrival to check availability.
- We cannot guarantee a tee time without a reservation.
- **For safety purposes, all golfers must check in with Golf Shop or Starter upon arrival.**

**Our starters manage the first tee to optimize course accessibility and availability. Starters have discretion of the first tee.**

## **GROUP BOOKINGS/MINI OUTINGS:**

- A block of up to 10 tee times (40 golfers) can be reserved by any eligible golfer at least 2 weeks in advance. Limit 1 per season.
- Group outings restricted to non-peak golfing times, limited availability.

**Radrick Farms community members must ensure guests follow all Golf Course policies and may be held accountable for any violations by their guests.**

## **EXPECT RESPECT. Our Campus Climate.**

The University of Michigan has, as one of its core values, an abiding commitment to sustaining a community in which the dignity of every individual is respected. Key to this value are efforts to foster and nurture an environment of civility and mutual respect by preventing discrimination and harassment on our campus.

- Radrick Farms Golf Course supports and promotes the University of Michigan's efforts to ensure equal opportunity for all persons regardless of race, color, national origin, age, marital status, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, disability, religion, height, weight, or veteran status in employment, educational programs and activities.

- Our golfers, Team members, and guests must behave in a friendly manner in order to encourage an enjoyable golf experience.
- Violations of policies and instances of aggressive, rude, boorish behavior, offensive comments of a sexual nature, etc. may result in a suspension of playing privileges or revocation of access privileges.
- Good golf course etiquette results in faster rounds, better course conditions, and greater enjoyment of the game.
- Policies contained within the University of Michigan's Standard Practice Guide apply to Radrick Farms.

# ***POLICIES*** CONTINUED

## **PACE OF PLAY POLICY**

- The turn from front to back nine should be made within two hours.
- Throughout the season, the standard may change for conditions beyond our control such as extreme heat or cart restrictions.
- Wednesdays are “Modified Pace of Play” days (\*MPD)
- Golfers not maintaining the pace of play standard may be required to skip a hole to close the gap **at any point** on the course.
- The Starter has discretion in determining the appropriate action to reduce or eliminate slow play and course “back-ups”.
- Playing through is discouraged on most days.
- First daily tee time cannot make turn before 1:45 of play.

**Pace of Play:  
4:15 for 18 holes.**

**While keeping up with the group in front of you is appreciated, it is not the standard.**

## **ADDITIONAL ETIQUETTE**

- Proper golf attire is encouraged.
- Please refrain from using electronic devices at high volumes when around others and/or in highly trafficked areas.
- Help us protect the natural beauty of the course by being respectful of the environment and all wildlife.



# ***POLICIES*** CONTINUED

---

## **GOLF CART PERMISSIONS & INFORMATION**

- Maximum of 2 golf carts per group.
- Only two riders and two golf bags are permitted per golf cart.
- Golfers must be 18+ to rent and operate a golf cart (per University of Michigan EHS policy).
- Persons with medical needs will receive a medical flag, granting the use of the “90 degree rule” on restricted holes and park carts within 10 feet of the greens (subject to conditions).
- Season Pass Holders assume personal use liability upon purchase of pass.
- All riders must pay the riding cart fee.

## **GOLF CART RESTRICTIONS & SAFETY RULES**

- Keep carts at least 30 feet away from greens and tees.
- Please operate carts on paths and obey all directional signs when possible.
- Never operate golf carts between bunkers and greens.
- Do not stand on the back or side of the golf cart while it is in motion.
- Do not dangle feet outside of the cart.
- Users of golf carts are responsible for all negligent damage to persons, carts, and all other property.
- All carts are due at the Clubhouse by sunset.



# ***POLICIES*** CONTINUED

---

## **NEW FOR 2026: GOLF COURSE TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE (GCTV) TRAIL FEE**

- A trail fee is being implemented for all GCTV users (includes E-bikes) to support course maintenance and ensure the continued quality of paths and infrastructure.
- **The daily pass is available for \$10 per day of use.**
- **A seasonal pass is also available for a one-time fee of \$100, covering GCTV use for the entire season.**



**All GCTV users must pay a trail fee.  
Daily (\$10) or seasonal (\$100) options available.**

## **GCTV PERMISSIONS & INFORMATION**

- Golfers operating a GCTV must complete the Golf Course Transportation Vehicle Waiver per University policy. Visit the Golf Shop to complete the waiver.
- **All GCTV and E-Bike users must pay trail fee. (Daily or Seasonal)**

## **GCTV RESTRICTIONS & SAFETY RULES**

- Keep GCTVs at least 30 feet away from greens and tees.
- Operate GCTVs on paths and obey all directional signs when possible.
- Never operate GCTVs between bunkers and greens.
- Users of GCTVs are responsible for all negligent damage to persons, carts, and all other property.

# ***POLICIES*** CONTINUED

## **BUNKERS**

- Always rake the bunkers.
- Never walk up the bunker faces.
- Leave rakes in the bunkers, parallel with the ball's line-of-flight from the tee to the pin.



**Please always rake the bunkers after use.**

## **TRAVEL BETWEEN NINES**

- Please do not walk across the first tee when walking from the ninth to the tenth hole.
- Follow cart path around the rear of the first tee.
- The 10<sup>th</sup> tee is reserved for you 2 hours from your actual starting tee time.
- Golfers in the first tee time each day should wait to begin the back nine if they complete the front nine in less than 1 hour and 45 minutes.

## **CHECK-IN PROCEDURE**

- 20 minutes prior to tee time: Golfers checked-in with Golf Shop and notify starter of their presence.
- 10 minutes prior to tee time: golfers must arrive at the tee, ready to play.
- Season Pass Holders have the option to check-in outside with the Starter if walking.
- Daily fee and guest golfers must check-in with the Golf Shop.
- Golfers not checked-in and at the tee 10 minutes prior to tee time may be subject to loss of their tee time.

**Season Pass Holders can check-in outside at the Starter Station.**

---

## **CANCELLATIONS & NO-SHOW PENALTY**

In an effort to create more access for our golfers, we are continuing to enforce the following No-Show policy:

- Reservations should be cancelled or updated with as much notice as possible. Early cancellation is an appreciated golfer courtesy.
- Please let us know if you need to cancel your tee time or reduce the number of golfers in your group the evening prior to your date of play by calling the Golf Shop or emailing us at [radrick1965@umich.edu](mailto:radrick1965@umich.edu).
- Please ensure all player information is as accurate as possible when booking a tee time. Please update all player info, once known, prior to round.

**Failure to cancel/update reservations will result in suspension of online booking privileges and/or a \$50 fee per golfer.**

Available spots behind the cart barn are **ONLY** for handicap parking. Cart barn parking prohibited for regular golf or driving range use (see pages 20-21).

- Radrick welcomes you to make use of our community areas including: the Legacy Room, our back patio, porches, and picnic areas.
- You may rent the spaces in advance by contacting the Golf Operations Manager.
- Occasional reservations and events may limit access.

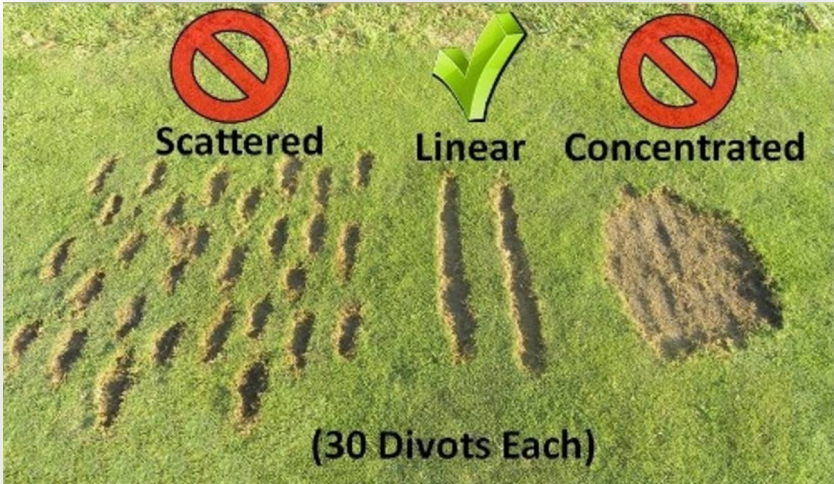


**Driving range use before your round is included with the purchase of greens fees on same day of purchase.**

## DRIVING RANGE

- Complimentary and unlimited use included with purchase of a Season Pass or Range Pass. **Please always display 2026 bag tag.**
- Complimentary practice balls for daily fee players and guests with purchase of greens fees, on same day of play.
- Range Passes, including unlimited access and range balls, may be purchased by eligible daily fee golfers.
- Range will be closed periodically for scheduled maintenance/events.
- Never hit off grass on designated “Mats Only” days.

## **PRACTICE GREENS**

- Radrick Farms has two large putting greens (see map on p.21)
- Please refrain from chipping practice at the green located behind the 10th hole tee box.
- Utilize the green closer to the parking lot for chipping practice.
- Shag bags can be borrowed from the Starter Station.
- Golfers are expected to pick up balls after use.

## **SHORT GAME AREA**

- For use of all Season Pass Holders and Range Pass Holders.
- Daily Fee Players may use these facilities on day of play.
- Golfers are expected to pick up balls after use.
- The short-game practice area is located beyond the end of the driving range, between the 10th and 14th fairway.
- Access this area by taking the path behind the driving range tee box.

## **GOLF INSTRUCTION—NEW FOR 2026!**

- Golf lessons and instruction available from Kelsey McDougall, LPGA.
- Season Pass Holders have priority access.

## **RENTAL CLUBS**

- Driver's license or major credit card are held as collateral.
- Rental fee rates vary based on quality of sets.
- Please call the golf shop in advance to reserve sets.

## **LOCKER AND CLUB STORAGE**

- The men's locker room has lockers available for annual rental.
- Club storage rental options are available for club, push cart and electric push cart storage.
- Due to limited space, priority will be given to Season Pass Holders renewing their lockers and/or storage.
- Please note that charging electronic devices in the Clubhouse is strictly prohibited per University policy.

# ***SCHEDULE & COMMUNICATIONS***

## **MAINTENANCE**

In order to satisfy as many golfers as possible, the following efforts are taken to ensure the most enjoyable golf experience possible:

- Most tasks are completed on a daily basis prior to daily play.
- The first group of golfers may not play at a pace faster than one hour and forty-five minutes for the first 9 holes.
- For safety and regulatory reasons, the course will be periodically closed for additional maintenance tasks, including chemical applications, tree removal, etc.

- The Team at Radrick Farms strive to be great environmental stewards; please read our [Environmental Stewardship Guide](#) under the “Course Info” tab on our website.

# ***SAFETY & WEATHER***

---

We are committed to providing the safest and best playing conditions possible. Occasionally, the course will unexpectedly close due to inclement weather. Please be patient and considerate during these times. When the course opens after a delay, tee times will be allocated at the Starter's discretion.

## **FROST DELAYS**

During frost delays, golfers must stay off ALL grass areas including the putting greens and driving range. Please help us protect the Golf Course from damage! Visit the [USGA website](#) for more information.



## **FOG DELAYS**

To ensure the safety of our golfers and staff, all play will be delayed until conditions are safe. Play will resume at the Starter's discretion.

## **RAIN & STORMS**

The course may close if significant rainfall renders the golf course susceptible to damage from golfer traffic. Golf carts may be restricted depending upon the conditions.

## **RAINCHECKS**

Golfers will be issued a physical raincheck whenever they are unable to complete their round due to unforeseen circumstances. Golfers **must** present this raincheck in the Golf Shop to redeem. Rainchecks expire at the end of the same calendar year as when they were issued.

**A raincheck for the full 18 holes will be issued whenever golfers are unable to complete their round due to unforeseen circumstances.**

## **LIGHTNING SAFETY**

- Golfers are responsible for maintaining awareness and exercising reasonable judgement.
- Do not wait for a siren. Sirens may not be audible at different spots on the Golf Course depending on ambient noise.
- Stay away from your golf clubs.
- Go indoors or go to a designated lightning shelter at first detection of thunder. Do not stand under a lone tree.
- If the course sirens sound, seek shelter immediately.
- Per University guidelines, a 20-minute delay of play will follow the last-detected strike.
- **Immediately Suspend Play** = Intermittent Hi-Low Tones
- **Safe to Resume Play** = Continuous, Solid Tone

**Golfers are responsible for maintaining awareness of weather and exercising reasonable judgment.**

## **ADDITIONAL SAFETY**

- If you are witnessing or experiencing an emergency situation, please call 911 immediately and notify the Golf Shop if possible.
- Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) are located throughout the Clubhouse. Select Team Members are CPR-trained.
- Please report any suspicious activity to the Golf Shop.



# ***COURSE ACCESS & PARKING***

---

Radrick Farms features three main parking areas that may be accessed by turning at the first right along Pete Dye Dr.

For those with **ADA access needs** (or for short term business needs), a fourth lot can be accessed behind our Cart Barn by continuing on Pete Dye Dr. and turning right onto Alice Dye Circle. This will lead to the circle drive in front of the clubhouse and turning right in front of golf shop and continuing behind the cart barn.

Our team is always willing to shuttle you to and from the parking lot if you are short on time.

**Parking behind the cart barn is not to be used for driving range access.**

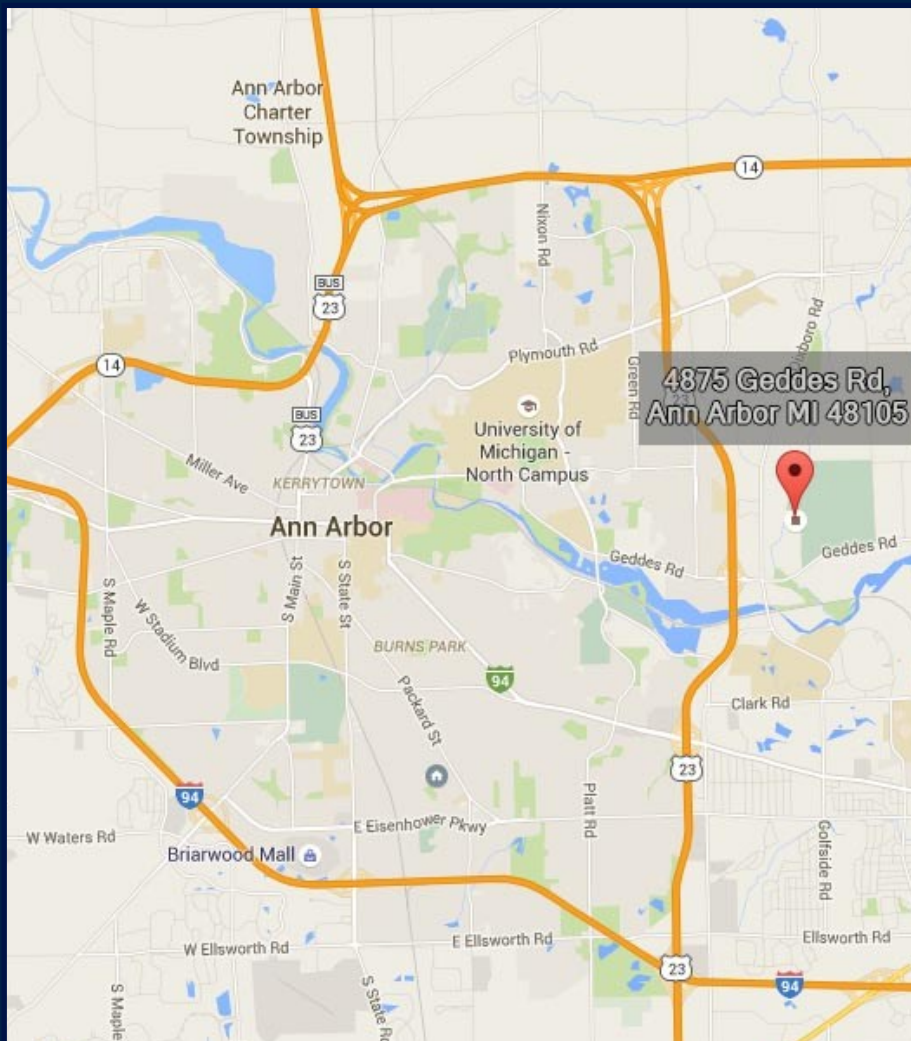
